



## Getting there Public transport

### Taxi:

The return fare from the official white airport cab companies is around **€90** round trip. When compared to the cost of car rental and the freedom that a rental car would give, this is expensive. However it is available 24/7.

### Train/taxi:

The train runs every half hour from the airport to the terminus in Fuengirola. The cost one way is around 6€ for two people. From there a cab to Las Acacias will cost around 15€ - so around **42€** return. However, this option is arrival and departure time sensitive.

Each of these options will get you door to door.

### Train/bus:

Alternatively, you can get the bus from Fuengirola Coach Station to Torrenueva and that would cost 3€ for two. So not surprisingly this is the cheapest @ **18€** return but the most personally demanding.

To a large degree, the economics, how intrepid you want to be and the time of arriving and departing will make a difference.

It is all a matter of what you feel comfortable with. When you are at 6D you will be in a small hamlet where you can walk to the beach, the local supermercado and a small group of restaurants and a bar. You can also eat/drink on the beach. Everything is within five minutes.

Additionally, there is a taxi rank (with one taxi!) and the bus towards Malaga and the other way to Marbella, stops alongside Torrenueva.

However, you don't need to do any more than stay locally around the pool or on the beach and forget the rest!
